WHEREAS, the City of Eastpointe is being proactive in litter prevention by working with residents, commercial businesses and civic organizations to educate and assist in creating a cleaner community.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Eastpointe, does herby proclaim a Clean City Initiative for Litter and encourages all citizens to work together, stand firm against the act of littering, and to act responsibly throughout the year for a cleaner community to preserve the natural beauty, quality of life, and health of our community.
